energy efficiency, the City of La Puente is offering a **FREE** retrofit of up to five (5) CFL's at 14 watts to replace incandescent bulbs at 60 watts for La Puente residents. Applications are available at La Puente City Hall and online at www.lapuate.org. Applications must be filled out in full, signed, and received at the City of La Puente Public Works Department to be eligible for review. Proof of ownership and residency is required. Please note, only one request is available per residence.

Funding for this program is provided by the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program administered by the U. S. Department of Energy. The objective of this Program is to reduce energy use and fossil fuel emissions and improve energy efficiency. The Program represents a Presidential priority to deploy the cheapest, cleanest, and fastest energy sources. EECBG was authorized in Title V, Subtitle E of the Energy Independence and Security Act (EISA), signed into law on December 19, 2007.

 - * signed Cancellation Policy

Applications maybe be submitted up to one year in advance for resident non-profit organizations, residents, and La Puente commercial businesses. All other reservation can be made six months in advance.

Meeting Rooms

The La Puente Community Center offers three (3) modern meeting rooms for reservation.

Workman Room has a maximum audience capacity of sixty (60) people.

Rowland Room has a maximum audience capacity of forty (40) people.

Walnut Room has a maximum audience capacity of fifty (50) people.

Picnic Shelters

The City of La Puente, Recreation Services Department, has now made a select number of picnic shelters available for rent at La Puente Park. Reservations must be made two weeks prior and no more than ninety days in advance with a two hour minimum. Signs will be posted at each picnic shelter to notify the public of the reservation. Picnic Shelters not reserved will be made available based on a first come first serve basis. A Park Reservation Application and a Picnic Shelter Rules and Regulations Form must be filled out and returned to the La Puente Youth Learning Activity Center during regular business hours.
