City Council Meeting Highlights

At the November 10 meeting, a resolution was adopted supporting the Los Angeles County launching of the Brag About Your Bag® Campaign and Ordinance No. 09-892, the changing of the election date from a

consolidated school district election in November of odd years to a stand alone election in April of even years, was read by title only and introduced.

At the November 24 meeting, a public hearing was held

considering the reduction of fees and other charges for recreation programs and the use of facilities and approving the residency requirement at 51%. No new business was considered.

The City of La Puente is seeking community-spirited people to fill scheduled vacancies on the **Education Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, Planning Commission, and Puente Pride Award Committee.**

Each member of the City Council appoints a member to the **La Puente Education Commission** to advise Council as to education, scholarships, youth activities, youth safety and other issues of mutual benefit to the school districts and the City. The commission meets when needed. Members are required to be residents of the City of La Puente.

The **Parks and Recreation Commission** will be appointed by the City Council to advise on matters relating to recreation programs, youth sports leagues, youth activities, citywide special

events, and other related issues. They meet at 6:00 p.m. the third Thursday of even numbered months. Members are required to be residents of the City of La Puente.

The **Planning Commission** meets the first Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. This five member Commission is appointed by the City Council and serves two year staggered terms, expiring January 30 of each year. The Planning Commission advises the City Council on matters that could result in either zoning or General Plan amendments. The Commission also hears appeals of zoning decisions and reviews development and land use permit applications. The goal of the Commission is to help create and maintain a well-planned community with compatible land usage.

Members are required to be registered voters and residents of the City of La Puente.

The **Puente Pride Commission** meets prior to the three award periods (Spring, Summer and Holiday decoration) to coordinate the home selection of awards. Members must be residents of the City of La Puente.

Applications are available at La Puente City Hall during regular business hours and on the City's website www.lapuente.org. To be considered for the Commissions, all applications must be submitted by **5:30 p.m. on Monday, January 11, 2010.** For more information, please call (626) 855-1500.

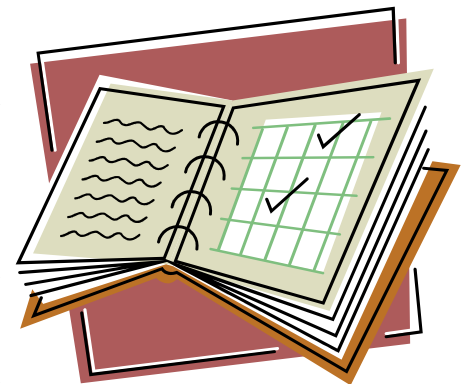
