La Puente's Sales Tax Update for Fourth Quarter 2017

City Manager David Carmany announced today that the City's sales tax receipts for the period of October through December 2017, were up 2.9%. During the fourth quarter period for 2017, receipts for all of Los Angeles County and the Southern California region were up 2.7 %.

The growth is still solid and does not yet point to a slowdown. The City experienced solid results from multiple local eateries as interest in dining out continues to grow, especially at quick-service restaurants. Strong sales of used cars helped boost auto-transportation returns.

Steady price increases at the pump, mostly due to the global cost of crude and the implementation of SB-1, statewide legislation that increased excise tax on fuel, pushed service stations higher.
