

RESOLUTION NO. 14-5128

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA PUENTE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON APRIL 8, 2014, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS MAY BE PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of La Puente, California, on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Election Code of the State of California, for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-5098 adopted on October 8, 2013, the duly appointed Election Official canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA PUENTE, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the whole number of votes cast in the precincts including the vote by mail ballots and provisional ballots, was 2,817 ballots cast in the City.

Section 2. That the names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council are as follows:

Valerie Muñoz	1057 Votes
David E. Argudo	915 Votes
Vince House	845 Votes

Section 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates are as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

Section 4. The City Council does declare and determine that:

Valerie Muñoz was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years;

David E. Argudo was elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election showing: (1) the whole number of votes cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) for what office each person was voted for; (4) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person; the total number of votes given to each person.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall cause to be administered to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

Section 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.






