These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the *City of La Puente*.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about April 29, 2026, the *City of La Puente* will submit a request to the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of Community Project Funds to undertake a project known as the *La Puente Park Activity Center Project* at 501 Glendora Avenue, La Puente, California, Los Angeles County, 91744, for the purpose of construction of a multigenerational facility at the *La Puente City Park*. The Project would propose a recreational facility, offering residents of all ages a new modern facility to exercise, socialize and participate in various community events and classes.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The *City of La Puente* has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the *City of La Puente* to jgalvan@lapuente.org. All comments received by April 29, 2026, will be considered by the *City of La Puente* prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The *City of La Puente* certifies to HUD/Los Angeles Office of Community Planning and Development (LA CPD) consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's State's approval of the certification satisfies

its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the *City of La Puente* to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

***HUD/State* will accept objections to its release of fund and the *City of La Puente's* certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the *City of La Puente*; (b) the *City of La Puente* has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by *HUD/State*; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD Los Angeles Office of Community Planning and Development (CPD) at CPDLA@hud.gov. Potential objectors should contact Los Angeles CPD via email at CPDLA@hud.gov to verify the actual last day of the objection period.**
